### 1. THE KEY TO ADVERSITY IS HOW IT IS HANDLED

<sup>12</sup> There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death.

**Proverbs 14:12 (ESV)**

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. **Proverbs 3:5-6 (ESV)**

<sup>32</sup> Although God gives him grief, yet he will show compassion too, according to the greatness of his loving-kindness. <sup>33</sup> For he does not enjoy afflicting men and causing sorrow. **Lamentations 3:32-33 (TLB)**

<sup>28</sup> We are assured *and* know that [God being a partner in their labor] all things work together and are [fitting into a plan] for good to and for those who love God and are called according to [His] design *and* purpose. **Romans 8:28 (AMP)**

<sup>33</sup> God's riches, wisdom, and knowledge are so deep that it is impossible to explain his decisions or to understand his ways. **Romans 11:33 (GW)**

### 4. TO STAND STRONG IN THE STORMS OF LIFE: (From *Standing Strong*, by Charles Stanley)

- a) Start with God's Word and decide now that you will honor the Lord regardless of what happens or what He asks of you. (Mt. 7:24)
- b) Keep your main focus on God Himself. (Ps 32:8)
- c) Fight your battles on your knees. (Eccles. 5:1-2)
- d) Diligently sow trust and obedience in your life. (Gal 6:8)
- e) Accept the challenge you are facing is hitting you where you are weak so that the Holy Spirit can pour His life through you and be your source of strength. (Eph. 1:19-20)
- f) Make sure you not only remain in fellowship with other believers, but you actively seek to pour Christ's life into them. (Heb. 10:23-25)
- g) See everything that happens as coming from God Himself for the very purpose of making you stronger. It is all for your benefit (1 Pet. 5:10; Rom. 8:28-29)
