³⁴ A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. ³⁵ By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." *John 13:34-35 (ESV)*

1. BEARING BURDENS (GAL. 5:26 - 6:5)

²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. *Galatians 5:26 (ESV)*

¹ Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. ² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. ³ For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. ⁴ But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor. ⁵ For each will have to bear his own load. *Galatians 6:1-5 (ESV)*

¹³ For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. *Galatians 5:13 (ESV)*

⁸ Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. *1 Peter 4:8 (ESV)*

²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. *Galatians 5:26 (ESV)*

- The legalist has an attitude of pride and condemnation

¹² Therefore let anyone who thinks he stands [who feels sure that he has a steadfast mind and is standing firm], take heed lest he fall [into sin]. *1 Corinthians 10:12 (AMP)*

⁵ For every person will have to bear (be equal to understanding and calmly receive) his own [little] load [of oppressive faults]. *Galatians 6:5 (AMP)*

2. SHARING _____ (GAL. 6:6-10)

⁶ Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches. ⁷ Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. ⁸ For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. ⁹ And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. *Galatians 6:6-10 (ESV)*

- **The Precept:** share with one another (vs. 6)
- **The Principle:** you reap what you sow (vv. 7-8)
- **The Promise:** in time you will reap if you don't grow weary (vs. 9)
- **The Perspective:** do good to everyone especially Christians (vs. 10)

²⁶ He said to him, "What is written in the Law? How do you read it?" ²⁷ And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." ²⁸ And he said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live." ²⁹ But he, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" *Luke 10:26-29 (ESV)*

³⁷ He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go, and do likewise." *Luke 10:37 (ESV)*

¹¹ Now may our God and Father himself, and our Lord Jesus, direct our way to you, ¹² and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you, ¹³ so that he may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his saints. *1 Thessalonians 3:11-13 (ESV)*
