A. I was born with a selfish _____ to sin

¹⁴ We know that the law is spiritual, but I am not spiritual since sin rules me as if I were its slave. ¹⁵ I do not understand the things I do. I do not do what I want to do, and I do the things I hate. ¹⁶ And if I do not want to do the hated things I do, that means I agree that the

law is good. ¹⁷ But I am not really the one who is doing these hated things; it is sin living in me that does them. **Romans 7:14-17 (NCV)**

²³ But I see another law working in my body, which makes war against the law that my mind accepts. That other law working in my body is the law of sin, and it makes me its prisoner. **Romans 7:23 (NCV)**

² But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear. **Isaiah 59:2 (NIV)**

⁸ Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. **Galatians 6:8 (NLT2)**

A. Understand what Jesus did for me

²⁴ Christ carried our sins in his body on the cross so that freed from our sins, we could live a life that has God's approval. His wounds have healed you. **1 Peter 2:24 (GW)**

⁹ But you are not like that. You are controlled by your new nature if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (And remember that if anyone doesn't have the Spirit of Christ living in him, he is not a Christian at all.) **Romans 8:9 (TLB)**
